Introduction:



College of Law was established in 1988 aiming at providing the Ministry of Justice with a specialized staff to improve the path of justice, including judges, investigators and assistant judges. Besides, it provides other ministries with justice officers, for instance, notary publics, minority care, property registry, and giving consultant advice if needed. Moreover, the College aims at establishing high scientific principles and developing jurisdiction through competent

scientific strategy in higher education and cultivating specialized teachers in the field of law and its concomitants .The College exerts itself to keep pace with the most recent scientific development in preliminary and higher education and develops the programming of suggested syllabuses before applying them .It also encourages scholarships to overcome the vacancy in law specializations of both the private and public sectors. Besides, the College qualifies teachers for keeping pace with modernity, and it develops study halls, buildings and modern technological labs. It also decides scientific projects, thesis titles, and dissertation titles that are submitted by scientific branches. In return, the College takes the responsibility of bringing them into effect. Objectives:

The College hopes to establish and convey legal principles in preliminary and higher studies. It also develops jurisdiction through law researches and cultivates specialized teachers in both science of law by establishing higher studies in both private and public branches. It encourages the development of suggested subjects in both preliminary and higher studies.

Services:

The College provides various legal and consultant services through the Legal Consultant Bureau. It also holds special meetings and discussions to delineate some law legislations, especially in the time when Iraq lives a transient period of having new legislations which are in need of study and analysis.

Registration:

The College comprises a developed registry unit that looks after students' affairs by carrying out the following duties:

- Registration new candidates at the outset of every academic year.
- Implementing orders of the College that concern students and giving them documents that certify their presence and regular attendance.

- Issuing student identity cards every academic year.

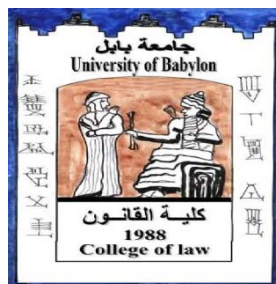
