Asking the Way and Giving Directions

Some Vocabulary and expressions for Asking for the Way and Giving Directions

In this lecture you will learn how to ask for the way and how to give directions for someone. To do this you need to learn a number of vocabularies that are common in this regard. The following list includes some of these vocabulary:

- It is on the left
- It is on the right
- It is straight on
- Opposite
- Near
- Next to
- Between
- At the end of (e.g. Oxford Street)
- On the corner of ... (e.g. James road)
- At the end of ... (e.g. Stanley Street)
- Behind the ... (e.g. Petrol station)
- In front of the (e.g. Mall)
- Just around the corner for here

There also some expressions that are useful to be learned to be able to give directions, the following table includes some of them:

- From Go over the roundabout take the second exit at the roundabout turn right at the T-junction
- ➤ Go under the bridge
- ➤ Go over the bridge.
- ➤ You will cross some railway lines
